Then his Honor was pleas'd to declare that with Advice of her Majesty's Council
he thought fit to Prorogue this present Generall Assembly to the Ninth
Day of March next and Prorogued them Accordingly; Mr Speaker and
the House return to their own House where Mr Speaker resumed the Chair and
declared the Honble Presid. pleas'd for Proroguing this present Generall
Assembly and the House Accordingly Prorogued themselves to the aforesaid
Ninth Day of March next. So Ended this Present Session of Assembly
on Saturday the 14th Day of November in the 52th year of her Maj
Reign.
