 Seal of this Province. Which Laws being so signed & sealed his Ex^{ty} was pleased
 to acquaint the House that he by the Advice of her Majesty's Council thought
 it convenient for her Majesty's Service to prorogue them until the 24th Day
 of July next and that they were thereby accordingly prorogued.
