John Small enters the House and delivers Bill requiring the Lord Baltimore's Agents to publish his Instructions &c Indorsed By the Council in Assembly April 12th 1707 Read in Council and past with Amendments Signed & Order W Bladen (S^c)

Read again in the House with the Amendments and do pass for engrossing Engrossed Bill empowering a Committee to lay the Levy &c Indorsed Read and assented to by the House of Delegates

Engrossed Bill reviewing an Act for Direction of Sheriffs &c Indorsed Read and assented to by the House of Delegates

Both which engrossed Bills were sent up to his Excellency and Council by Mr John Hudson for their Honours Assent. He returns and says he delivered the Bills
