Colo Whittington also brings the Bill for continuing Saint Marys County Court House at Shepherds Old Fields Indorsed By the Council in Assembly 31<sup>st</sup> October 1710 Read the first Time and will pass with the Amendments proposed, or rather as new drawn W Bladen J. C.

Ordered the new Bill be read Samuel Young Esq, enters the House and delivers Mr Speaker his Petition Memorial of Mr Bladen. Ordered they be considered to Morrow Morning William Coursey Esq, from the Council enters the House and delivers Mr Speaker Bill for continuing Queen Anns County Court House at Queens Town Indorsed Eodem Die Read the first and Second Times in Council and will pass W Bladen J. C.

The said Bill read again in the House and past for ingrossing Bill reinvesting Swards Heirs in a certain Tract of Land Read and indorsed - By the House of Delegates October 31<sup>st</sup> 1710 Read the first Time and Ordered a second Reading to Morrow Morning

Bill continuing Saint Marys County Court House at Seymour Town Read and indorsed By the House of Delegates 31<sup>st</sup> 1710 Read the first and Second Times and by especial Order will pass Rich Dallam J. Ho. Del.
