Ordered that the Justices of Prince Georges County first do not presume to levy any Tobs.
 on the County for keeping the Ferry at Mount Calvert and that Mr Stoddart, Mr Tanghill
 Doctor Claudius and Mr Flagett, four Justices that caused the Ferry to be kept contrary
 to the Order of this House pay to the Clerk of this House £500 Tobs for all fees due to him
 upon Quaerion of the Petition Signed by Order Rich Dallam &c Do. Deb.
