

- 15 An Act to rectify a Mistake in the Writing the last Will & Testament of the Reverend John Edwards late of Baltimore County deceased and for settling an Estate of Inheritance in fee simple on John Stokes the Devisee in the said Will named -
- 16 An Act for settling and vesting an Estate of Inheritance in fee simple of and in one hundred and fifty Acres of Land lying in Calvert County on William Hickman of Calvert County Carpenter Son and Heir of William Hickman deceased and by the said Hickman the Father purchased of and from a certain Thomas Hinson
- 17 An Act empowering Robert Roberts of Queen Anne's County to sell Part of a Tract of Land lying in Cecil County called New Munster late the Land of John Toas for the Uses therein mentioned and to make good and valid such Sale -
- 18 An Act investing two Tracts of Land in Richard Bennett Esq. late the Land of John Howel deceased
- 19 The Act for Naturalization of Peter Saunders of Talbot County Planter and his Children, Stephen Roshorn of the same County Planter, and Wm. Goby of Charles County Taylor and his Children
- 20 An Act for Relief of John Clements of Talbot County Son of John Clements late of Talbot County and Legatee of Ann the Daughter of the said John Clements the elder and the Children of Thomas Clements and Mary Inehudd being all the legal Representatives of the said John Clements the Elder -

All and every of which said Bills the Honble President was pleased to Enact into Laws by sealing each of them with the great Seal of this Province and indorsing them in the following Manner

After which the Honble President was pleased to declare that with Advice of her Majesty's Honble Council he thought fit to prorogue this present General Assembly until the 29th Day of November Instant - Whereupon Mr. Speaker and the Members returned to their own House and prorogued themselves accordingly.
