Wednesday Afternoon The House met again according to Adjournment and being called over were present as in the Morning.

Ordered Mr. Hunt and Mr. Gale lay before this House to Morrow Morning her Majesty's gracious Proclamation and the late Act of Parliament for regulating foreign Sains and Resolved this House will then consider thereof.

The Committee for Election and Privileges enter the House and by John Walter Smith their Chairman deliver Mr. Speaker their Report.

That Part of the Report relating to the Sheriff's Return of Talbot County first under Consideration being debated. Resolved it is a good Return and Queen Ann's likewise as to Saint Mary's County Returns now under Consideration and referred. Ordered that the Papers against them be delivered John Code and that the Members have Liberty to withdraw in Order to prepare themselves against to Morrow Morning.

The House adjourns till to Morrow Morning Eight o'clock.

Thursday the 30th September 1708 The House met again according to Adjournment, being called over were present as Yesterday. Read what was done Yesterday.

The House proceeds to the Consideration of his Excellency's Speech. And as to that Part relating to the Gauge of Tobacco Hogsheads and Masters of Ships cropping Tobacco on Board their Ships Resolved a Message be prepared and sent to his Excellency and Council to desire a Conference with some of the Members of her Majesty's Honble Council and some of this House which follows.
