

And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance that the long and tedious May
prescribed by the Act for Attachments and the great and extravagant Charges thereof before
an Attachment can be obtained against any Person that leaves the Province or otherwise not
to be found doth not answer the Intent and Design of the Said Act
Resolved the House concur with the Committee that it is an Aggrievance and that they will the
next Session of Assembly consider of the Means to redress the same

And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance that no Care is taken for the
Payment of the Charge and Expences of such Jurors, Evidences and other poor Persons as are
obliged to attend the Provincial Court, ready Money being the only Thing that the Ordinary
Keepers will accommodate them for, and that being not to be had, occasions them to want
such Accomodations as are necessary at their Attendance on the Said Court
Resolved the House will the next Session of Assembly consider of the Means to redress
this Aggrievance.

And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance
that there is no Act of Assembly of this Province that declares which of the Statutes of
England are in force here it being now left to the Discretion of the Justices of the several
Courts to admit or deny them whereby it comes to pass that an Act of Parliament allowed
of in one Court is denied in the next by which Means her Majesty's Subjects know not
what Acts of Parliament they transgress or what are for their Relief

Resolved it is highly necessary ^{that} a Bill should pass to declare which of the Statutes
of England are necessary to be in force here and referred to the Consideration of the next Session
of Assembly. And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance that the
Act for Probate of Wills and granting Administrations &c is so dark and obscure in
several Particulars that it answers not the Intent and Design thereof, and particularly in
the Paragraph for Payment of Debts due in the Country before Debts due to Foreigners

Resolved the said Act wants several Amendments and that Debts due to Foreigners of
a higher Nature ought to be paid before Debts of an inferior Nature due to the Inhabitants
and referred to the Consideration of the next Session of Assembly

It is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance and Discouragement to the
Inhabitants of this Province that the Exportation of Neats Hides and Old Iron should be
allowed of Resolved this is an Aggrievance and that a Bill be brought in this Session
to prohibit the Exportation of Neats Hides and Old Iron

And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance to the Inhabitants of
Saint Mary's County, that some of the Justices of that County have given Liberty to one
Michael Wellman to build a Tipling House and sell Liquors on the said House and
very near the same which is much to the Dissatisfaction of the Inhabitants of the said
County and very dangerous if set on fire

Resolved it is an Aggrievance and that an Order issue to the Justices of Saint Mary's County
to suppress and remove the said victualling or Tipling House and they permit not the like for
the future.

And it is further offered by this Committee as an Aggrievance that Negroes
transgressing any Law that touches Life or Member should lie long in Prison after the committing
the fact and until a Provincial Court which runs the Country to vast Charge and that the Owners
of such Negroes endeavour to keep them from suffering being their proper Estate - All which
