Read what was done yesterday Richard Young's Petition praying Liberty to keep and stable Horses at the Gate House of ^{the} Read and Resolved Liberty be given him to keep and stable Horses sell Provender as formerly used by him and other Gate-keepers. Resolved Mr. Cadwallter Edwards fit up the Office in the Great House that formerly was allotted for the Town Clerk of Annapolis for the use of the Clerk of this House in all respects as the Council Office is now fitted up with Table Tom, Paper Holers ^{and} and to finish the work by the first of April next and to be paid by the Public for his work and all Expences for doing the same seven Pounds Current Money. And Ordered when the Office is fitted up the Journals and all Papers belonging to the Assembly be lodged therein and the Clerk of the Secretary's Office have the keeping the same when the Clerk of this is not in Town out of Assembly Times

Resolved the Clerk of this House record such of the Journals of this House as are to be found and to be paid for the same by the Public and that the Secretary deliver him the Journals for that Purpose

The House adjourned for an Hour. Eodem Die. The House met again according to Adjournment were called over and all present as before

Colo Addison and Colo Tilghman enter the House and deliver Mr. Speaker the same Bill Indorsed Nov^r 15th 1712 Read and assented to by her Majesty's Honble Council in Assembly and signed of Order W. Bladen N. Council

Ordered Mr. Daniel Mariantee and Mr. James Lloyd attend the Honble President's Council and acquaint that Honble Board this House have nothing before them & are ready to attend their Honour to compleat this Session. They return and say they delivered their Message. The Honble Samuel Young Esq. and Colo Tilghman enter the House and inform Mr. Speaker the Honble President commands him and the whole House immediately to attend him in the Council Chamber to compleat this Session
