By the House of Delegates October 28th 1713

Forasmuch as the Indentures returned to the Clerk of the Crown for the four Delegates of Baltimore County are not to be found whereby this House cannot admit them into the House and are thereby deprived of four of their Members

It is therefore Ordered by the House That the Sheriff of Baltimore County immediately on Receipt hereof return or bring to the Honble Speaker of this House the Counter Parts of the Indentures for the said Delegates and that the Sheriff of Ann Arund. County immediately send the Sheriff of Baltimore County with this Order who is commanded to comply therewith or show his Reasons to the contrary
