John Hale Esq; and Col. Addison from Council deliver Mr. Speaker the following Message viz<sup>t</sup> By the President and Council in Assembly Nov<sup>r</sup> 14<sup>th</sup> 1713

Out of a due regard we owe to her Majesty and a true sense we have of the Interest of the Province we have by many Messages endeavored to persuade your House to comply with her Majestys commands and these we affirm to be the only motives that have induced us to be so very importunate with you this Session and multiply so many Messages and must deny the same were used to gratify anyone or delay the Session which we look upon to be an unworthy Reflection and base Imputation thrown on the Board and which we cannot but highly resent as to any Reflections you may bestow upon us when you come to the several Counties in the vindicating your own Reputations we are above the consideration thereof well knowing if you shall know any expressions upon us they will be altogether unjust and groundless and whereas several of you are Justices in your Counties we must warn you as there is now no Law in force in this Province relating to Ordinaries you had best take care how you put any of the Laws of the Kingdom of Great Britain relating to Ale House Keepers and Victualers in force and Practice here unless you are well satisfied you are sufficiently empowered so to do.
