Your Message this afternoon by Mr James Boyd and five others of your Members has been read and considered at this Board and your Request therin is thought very reasonable Wherefore his Excy has been pleased to give Orders to her Majestys Admirals to lay the whole Accounts of the £~~3000~~ appropriated for the purchasing Arms and Ammunition for the Defence of this Province before your House at the next Session. And further his Excy and the Board do desire and are intitutable some Part of the aforesaid Revenue of £~~3000~~ appropriated as aforesaid may be applied towards the Building publick Stowhouses for preserving the publick Arms and Ammunition in the several Countys where necessary But as to the Stowhouse agreed to be built in this City his Excy desires it should not be further proceeded till the next Sessions of Assembly when some further Proposals will be made relating thereto
