the Said Receivers accordingly. But the same not being as yet done, we pray  
your Excellency further Directions about the same, and that an Account of the Treasures  
Forfeitures noted by the Said Receivers be likewise laid before this House this  
Session

her Majesty's Instructions to his Excellency being read, this House in Compliance  
therewith is resolved to view and inspect into the Laws of this Province and to  
repeal and amend such as shall on Consideration be found to want Amend-  
ment or Supplement and for the more speedy effecting the same we pray your  
Excellency and Honors will appoint some Members of your Honble Board to confer  
with some Members of this House to concert the Manner and Method for  
accomplishing the same.
