 Solo Richard Dilghman from the Honble Council enters the House and delivers
 Mr. Speaker the ingrossed Bill for adjusting the publick Charge of this Province
 and appointing a Committee to apportion the same for this present Year One
 thousand seven hundred and fourteen thus indorsed viz:

By the Council in Assembly October the 9th 1714 Read and assented to by
 her Majesty's Honble Council, and signed of Order W. Bladen H. Council
 And also acquaints him that his City the Gov. requires him and the whole House
 to attend him in the Council Chamber to see the said Law sealed and his City
 pass the Royal Assent thereto. The House accordingly adjourns to the Council
 Chamber where Mr. Speaker presented the said Bill to his City the Governour
 for the Royal Assent to be given thereto viz:

A Bill for adjusting the publick Charge of this Province and appointing a
 Committee to apportion the same for this present Year One thousand seven
 hundred and fourteen. Which said Bill his City the Gov. was pleased to enact
 into a Law by sealing the same with the great Seal of this Province and indorf-
 -ing it in the following Manner viz: October the 9th 1714 On Behalf of
 her Sacred Majesty Queen Ann of Great Brittain &c. I will this be a Law
 J. Hart.

After which his City the Gov. was pleased to declare that with the Advice
 of her Majesty's Honble Council he thought fit to prorogue this present
 General Assembly till the tenth Day of November next to which Time
 they were accordingly prorogued. Afterwards Mr. Speaker with the Rest of
