Upon reading your Writings in favour of Mr. Daniel Philips, surviving Adm. of Colo Henry Mitchell deceased of Calvert County deceased, and the said Daniel Philips Petition the Petitioner with his Council has been heard at this Board but not making good the Allegations in his Petition, or offering other sufficient Matter to induce his Excellency to suspend the Prosecution of his Majesty's Suit against him; it has been Resolved by this Board Nemine contradicente that it is not advisable for his Excellency to give any Directions for suspending the Prosecution of the said Suit; especially considering the express Instructions his Excellency hath received on those Occasions
