be given to Bonatus Smith Guardian of Anthony Swif's Heir to be and appear
before this House in Eight Days to be computed from the first Day of next Session
then to show sufficient Cause why the Petitioners Prayer should not be granted, and
in case of his Failure therein Leave is given the Petitioners to bring in there a Bill
as prayed.

Ordered That no Petitions be received this Session after Thursday next.
