The following Letter of Notice being read with the Oaths thereon Indorsed it is
Ordered to be entered as follows viz^t

To Mr Thomas Parramore October the 20th Day 1714

These comes to warn you Thomas Parramore to appear before our House of Af-
sembly in Maryland at the City of Annapolis to be held the 4th Day of 9th next
there to give your Reasons if any there be why an Act may not pass for Confirma-
tion of the Will of John Parramore late of Somerset County in favour of the three
Children of Amos Parramore concerning a Tract of Land called Weytuation lying
in Somerset County which is the Defise in Behalf of the Heirs J^r. Cadwole Jun^r.
April the 2^d 1715 - Then came John Davis before me and made Oath that last
October he being employed by John Cadwole Jun^r. went to the House of Thomas
Parramore and told him he was sent with this Letter over to him from John Cadwole
and let him see it and laid it on his Table and the said Parramore would not
receive this Letter and desired me to carry it to him again and that it should
not be left in his House and that Thomas Wilson who lives within a little
Way of the said Parramore told me that John Cadwole had formerly sent
Thomas Parramore a Letter to the same Purpofe of this and that it was in
said Wilson's House and Parramore would not let it be read to him
