a sufficient Notice and Mr. Samuel Hopkins and Mr. John Turnell undertake  
to give Thomas Parramore the said Notice.

Mr. Amos Garrett, Capt. James Harris and Mr. Joseph Hamilton are appointed  
a special Committee to examine the Complaint against Mr. Homoloy about embo-  
zzling the Arms and Magazine of this Province and are to make their Report  
known to the House by ten of the Clock to Monday Morning.
