 of Delegates by the Honble Council on the 6th of May 1712 against Philomon
 Homsley and Mary his wife lately called Mary Comte about embezelling some
 of the Arms and Ammunition of this Province delivered out of the publick-
 Stock at Annapolis in the Year 1706 to Rto. John Fontee deceased thought
 fit to call the said Philomon and Mary before the Bar of this House to answer
 the same. On Examination whereof it fully appears that the said Philomon
 and Mary his wife as she is Exe of the said Rto. John Fontee are still accountable
