Stone. They return and say they delivered the Mousquet.

Ordered the said Philomen Tomley and Mary his wife pay unto Thomas  
Maunomara Clerk of this House for all the Care and Trouble he has taken about  
the said Complaint the Sum of five Hundred Pounds of Tobacco; and to the  
Sergeant attendant of this House the Sum of one Hundred Pounds Tobacco; To  
the Doorkeeper of this House the Sum of fifty Pounds Tobacco.
