By his Excellty the Gov^r & Council in Assembly

3 July 2^d 1714
Your Message this after Noon by M^r James Loyd and 5 others of your
Memb^rs has been read & Considered at this Board and your request
herein is thought very reasonable wherefore his Excellty has been
pleas'd to give ord^r to her Matys Receivers to lay the whole acc^ts
of the 3^d & 4th appropriated for the purchasing Arms and Ammunition
for the Defence of this Province before your House at the next Session.
And further his Excellty & the Board do resolve and are inclinable some part of
the afo^r Revenue of 3^d & 4th appropriated as afo^r may be applyed towards the
building of publick Storehouses for preserving the publick Armes & Ammunition
in the severall Counties where necessary.

But as to the Storehouse, agreed to be built in this City his Excellty desires it should
not be further proceeded till the next Sessions of Assembly nor some further
proposalls will be made relating thereto - Signed & Ord^r W^m Bladen Sec^y

Thereupon Ordered that Capⁿ Douwa desist building the 3^d House till next
Session of Assembly.
