

Edw. Lloyd and Edw. Sam. Young from the Honble Council Enter  
the House and acquaint M<sup>r</sup> Speaker. That his Excellency the Gov<sup>t</sup> Commands him and the whole House to attend  
him at the Council Chamber to see the Laws made this Session sealed  
And his Excellency pass the Royall Assent thereto

The House accordingly adjourns to the Council Chamber where  
M<sup>r</sup> Speaker presented the following Bills to his Excellency the Gov<sup>t</sup> for the Royall  
Assent to be given thereto viz<sup>t</sup>

1<sup>st</sup> Bill for Revising and Continuing an Act of Assembly of this Province  
Entituled an Act for the ordering and regulating the Militia of this  
Province for the better security and defence thereof and for supplying  
some Defects therein

2<sup>d</sup> Bill for laying an Imposition of 3<sup>d</sup> Pence on Tobacco for Defraying  
the Charge of the Province

3<sup>d</sup> Bill for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some  
Aggravances in the Execution of Suits at Law

4<sup>th</sup> Bill reviving a certain Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled an  
Act for limitation of Officers Fees & for supplying some defects therein

And also reviving another Act of Assembly of this Province Entituled  
an Act Explaining some doubtfull Expressions in the Act for Limi-  
tation of Officers Fees

All and every of which said several Bills his Excellency the Gov<sup>t</sup> was pleased  
to enact & make into Laws by sealing each of them with the Great Seal of  
this Province and Endorsing each of them in the following Manner viz<sup>t</sup>

In behalfe of her said Maty Queen Anne  
of Great Brittain &c. - I will this be a Law

After which his Excellency the Gov<sup>t</sup> was pleased to Declare that with the  
advice of her Matys Honble Council, He thought fit to prorogue this  
General Assembly till the fifth Day of October Next to which time they were  
accordingly prorogued -

Afterwards M<sup>r</sup> Speaker with the rest of the Members of the House of  
Delegates returned to their own House - And then M<sup>r</sup> Speaker resumed  
the Chair and Spoke to the House that his Excellency the Gov<sup>t</sup> with the  
advice of her Matys Honble Council had prorogued this General  
Assembly till the fifth Day of October next - to which time this House  
Prorogues it selfe - So Endeth this present Session of Assembly  
being the 3<sup>d</sup> Session - on the 3<sup>d</sup> Day of July one thousand  
Seven hundred & fourteen
