

Sealed and his Excellency gave your royal assent thereto
The House accordingly adjourned to your Council Chamber where Mr. Gordon
presented your said Bill to his Excellency your Governor for your royal assent
to give thereto viz)

A Bill for adjusting the public Charge of this Province and appointing a
Committee to appoint your said Charge for the next Year One thousand seven hundred
and fourteen

Where said Bill his Excellency your Governor was pleased to enact into a
Law by sealing your said Bill with your great Seals of this Province and
enjoining it in your following manner viz)

October 9th 1714

On behalf of her Majesty Queen Anne of great Brittain &c I
will this be a Law

After which his Excellency your Governor was pleased to declare that with
your Advice of her Majesty's Honble Council he thought fit to prorogue this
your general Assembly till your tenth day of November next to which
time they were accordingly prorogued

Afterwards the Speaker with your rest of your Members of your House of
Delegates returned to their own House, and then the Speaker returned
your Claims and Reported to your House that his Excellency your Governor with
your Advice of her Majesty's Honble Council had prorogued this general
Assembly till your tenth day of November next, to which time this House
prorogued it self, so on to this present Session of Assembly being
the Session on your Ninth day of October One thousand seven
hundred and fourteen
