

# Maryland

An Assembly begun and hold at the City of Annapolis the twenty sixth day of April in the first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God Great Britain, France and Ireland and the Dominions therunto belonging King Defender of the Faith &c. Annoq. Dom: 1715 by virtue of his Majesty's writ of Habeas Corpus directed to the several and respective Sheriffs of the several Counties of this Province and to the Mayor Recorder and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, empowering the Freeholders of the several Counties to elect and Chose four Deputies or Delegates for each County and the said Mayor Recorder and Aldermen to Chose two Citizens for the City aforesaid to serve as Representatives of the several Counties and City of Annapolis in this present General Assembly, which said writs bore date the twenty fifth day of January 1714 returned this present twenty sixth day of April 1715 a fact at which time there assembled at the Madhouse in the City of Annapolis aforesaid in the County of Anne Arundel County the several members following viz
