His Excellency the Gov^r with the advice of the Board has thought fit to communicate to the house of Delegates
the two above written Royal Instructions

The house adjourns till to morrow morning Eight a Clock
Thursday morning 30th April 1715

The house met again according to Adjournment present as yet today
There was read the proceedings of this house on yesterday

Ordered that the following message be sent to his Excellency the Gov^r viz

Regarding the election of Roger Boyce to this House Complainings of an Embezzlement made off some
wood in a Record Book in Calvert County and on subscription of the Record Book and Examination of Mr
Aaron Dupuis Clerk to Mr Edward Boucher Clerk of Calvert County Court this House find reason to believe
and it is therefore resolved unanimously that an Embezzlement was made in the said Record
Book and as they have usual power to punish the Offender, we humbly desire your Excellency will be pleased
to commit the Attorney General to make a due Examination of the said Offender and that he do
bring the person suspected to be the Offender if found guilty to undergo Punishment that such abuses
