The Petition of the Petitioners for a new port Division of William and Marys Parish in Charles County being read this day in the House praying that Newport Hundred part of William and Marys Parish in Charles County May be reunited to King and Queens Parish in Anne Arundell County being read and the Question being putt whether the act of Assembly for uniting Newport Hundred to King and Queens Parish in Charles County shall be repeated or not

is Resolved in the affirmative by Majority of votes thereupon Ordered that the Delegates of St. Marys County be desired to bring in a bill for repealing the Act in this behalf
