His Report being read and debated, for that it appeared to this house
that the several Laws of this Province now in force are: scattered and dispersed
in several books and Editions Containing laws that also repealed. It is therefore resolved
that the Report be agreed to and his Excellency and the Hon^{ble} Commiss^r 1011
is required, and that for accomplishing the same: some member of the Hon^{ble}
Council may be appointed to form a Committee of Law

The House met according to adjournment present as in the morning.
