

And as to the Instruction relating to the Revising the Laws of this Province and sending a Complot Body for his Majesty's approbation or Disallowance the Consensus and Opinions that all such Laws of this Province that want amendment be printed and sent to his Majesty and the Lord Council for Trade and Plantations under special Warrant that all other Laws of this Province that seem to be good and useful and want no amendment it will be fit they be transcribed in Parliament and sent under separate Seals with the Other that a Complot Body of all our Law may be Collected together and sent home for his Majesty's approbation or Disallowance
