

Act of Jud. Allowys and Practitioners of the Law in the Court of this Province and for amending the same by way of Revision which was on the 21th of May 1715

Read the first and second time by Especiall Order and with pass and was endorsed —

The same is sent up to the Honble Council by Mr Wright and Mr Hopkins — They returne and say they Delivered the bill

Mr Thomas Robin from the Committee of Law. Delivered Mr. Speaker A Bill relating to Inward and Navos which was Ordered to be read on Monday Morning next —

Capl Thomas Dent from the Committee of Law Delivered Mr. Speaker the two bills following vizt —

A Bill for securing Merchants and Others Treasures after they have paid it and declaring the altering the marks or quality thereof to be felony and agt false packing —

Also a bill for Ordering and Regulating the Militia of this Province and for the better Defense and security thereof —

which said two bills are Ordered to be read on Monday morning next an Engrossed bill for ~~the same~~ brought down from the Committee of Law by Capl MacCall

A Bill for stay of Execution after the 25th of May yearly being read and Reported to by the House of Delegates was ordered to be thus endorsed vizt

May the 21th 1715

Read and Reported to by the House of Delegates and signed by Order Tho: Maccall and Mr. Harrison and Mr. Baker — They Returne and say they Delivered the bill

Major Roger Woolford from the Committee of Law Delivered Mr. Speaker the two following bills vizt

A bill prohibiting all Masters of Ships and vessels from transporting persons without passes

A bill for the appointment of Constables which bill was Ordered to be read on Monday morning next also an Engrossed bill for Machinery &c

The House adjourns till Monday Morning soon a Clock Monday Morning 29th of May 1715

The House next according to adjournment postponed Saturday except Mr. Day and Mr. Calverton
