write to Mr. Blackiston Agent for this Province about the
affairs of this Province wherein his negotiation is more par-
ticularly necessary

Mr. Samuel Young from the Honorable Council acquainted
Mr. Speaker with the Council's Command to him and the whole
House immediately to attend him in the Council Chamber
where Mr. Speaker and the House went to attend his
Excellency according to where his Excellency was pleased to deliver
the several bills following into Law by reading them with
the great Seal of this Province and signing them severally
in the manner following viz
