Wm 912 Governor's Speech

As your Majesty's dutiful and loyal subjects of the Province of Maryland the Governor and Upper and Lower houses of Assembly under the Great Seal of the Province of Baltimore Lord Proprietor of the said Province humbly beg leave to congratulate your Majesty upon the late glorious and happy success of your victorious Troops against the Rebels to your Honor and the perfect Subjection of our Civil Rights and Liberties.

May continued success attend all your Enemies ever attend you and heaven grant you your heart desire, we being convinced by the long experience of your Majesty known Wisdom magnanimity and Generosity what ever may be in your power which always terminates in the happiness of your Subjects, and as we have in effectually enjoyed whilst we were so that to be under the more immediate Government of your Majesty and your Royal predecessors which has been ever since the happy Revolution so absolutely necessary and justly beneficial to your Majesty's Kingdoms and Dominions thereof ever paid our selves to be accounted a small part

so we most humbly hope and submit since out of your Graciously beneficence we have been graciously pleased to restore the Lord Proprietor upon his Noble Father's his Inversion to the Quack of England to the Government of this Province your Majesty will still favorably condescend to continue to us the Influence of your Royal grace by earnestly recommending to his Majesty the case and Preservation of your faithful Subjects and the true Protestant Religion among us in this Province where we have very many dissenters to our Religion. Alas how long God long to continue your Majesty's Obedience to all your people and that we have the happiness to be under your Majesty's Gracious and powerful protection, so we may encourage to oppose our selves to your Majesty and your singular honor truly loyal ministers and virtuous Subjects and servants of the Province being Englishmen signed by his Majesty and all the members of the Upper and Lower houses of Assembly.
