U^p answer to your message relating to M^r. Speaker's allowance as a Councilor whilst he was president and also to your message yesterday relating to M^r. Speaker's demands on their revenue, We acquaint you that his Excellency King was very much displeas'd and your house very thin by the sickness and absence of several of our Members We desire you will refer those matters to the next s^{es}sions, this Board being unwilling at present to determine these affairs signed by order M^r. Speaker R. A. P. &c.

Which being read the said matters are referred to the Board of next s^{es}sions
