sail by which the G^{ve}ny will reason expect reasonness to be made him

for your G^{ve}ny's salary, This I shew'd you in my Instructions which I shew'd
not you h^{ad} before from Mr. Bodley. I desire therefore you will please to
give orders to the several officers in whose hands that Revenue is plac'd to
account with and pay me the same to his Shippers use for a very small
delay in this matter will be of great prejudice to his Shippers because though
he will still of it this year which I hope your G^{ve}ny will think fitt to prevent
I must humbly Recommend to your G^{ve}ny that question be not
in debating to some laws which I understand are prepar'd and wherby his
Shippers greatest will evidently suffers detriment without a salvo at least
