May it please Your Friends by the act made the 20th of August 1715
that the 18th of March raised to the right hon^{ble} the Primate's Town
and Baltimore in lieu and stead of the 12th of March raised to the
late Charles and Baltimore in Consideration of his taking his
Quiet Rents and Alienation fines in Subaccount: & C^o and was
bequeath to the several Marshall Officers by the Masters of every
Ship or Schooner: That the Marshall Officers on receipt of the 18th of March
were obliged to render an Account for and pay the same to the
publick Treasurers of this Province to be by the Treasurers
Accounted for and paid to the right Hon^{ble} the Board of Ordnance
Baltimore in Case he should be favourably pleased to except
the same in Consideration of his receiving his Duties & Rents and
Alienation fines in Subaccount & sending the same after such
Acceptance should and duly assigned to this Province otherwise
the said Money was to be applied to the Discharging the publick
Charge — We therefore humbly pray that they be assigned to
Colonel his Majesty's Treasurers of the said 18th of March —
Which his Majesty has dignified his Majesty to that his
said Majesty was willing to accept of the said 18th of March —
