And further the said Todd Declares upon his Oath that he has never received any Satisfaction for the Publick grounds within the City of Annapolis but that about the year he was Informed by Mr. Wm Foylond that he was Ordered 1200 and odd pounds of Tob: on the Shov. of Som: set County w. Tob: he never received nor know any further thereof - And further the said Sancellot Todd Declares that he veryly believes he never received any Satisfaction from Coll: Nicholson or Coll: Dorsy for any Lots by them hold in the City but remembers that Coll: Dorsy refused when Demanded - All which in compliance with the Direction of the House in the Act of assembly aft is humbly Reported to the Lower house of assembly Sign: Order Jack Denton Esq: to the Commissioner An Engrost bill for relief of John Beales and Rich: Beale a minor was read and ordered to be this Endust viz: June 4th 1719 Read and Reported to by the Lower house of assembly and signed Order M. Jenifer Esq: Lower house
