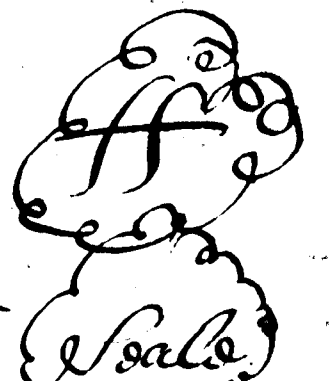

Proprietor we have thought fitt that the said Suspension be taken off
and do hereby Order and Direct that you the said John Hart
our Lieutenant Gov^r and Keeper of the great Seal of the
Province or in your Absence the keeper of the great Seal of the
Province for the time being do forthwith discharge the said Order
and all Orders Explanatory thereof, and restore the said Tho:
Macnemara to his practice in the said Court.
