On reading and Considering your Message of this Day by John Hall Esq. and two other members of your Honor^{ble} house on the Supplementary Act to the Act settling a Revenue on her Majesties Dowry Governour we are hartly sorry that we cannot come into the measures proposed by your house for vesting his Excellency with the Money according to that Message seeing we are uncertain how soon his Lordship may think fit to supersede His Excellencies Commission at what time by the intendment of that Law and the Construction of the Lord proprietor he can be no longer entitled to the same, so that this House would be wanting in their Duty

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
