Mr Rich^d Keen Deputy Sheriff of Prince Georges County makes the following
return Viz^t April 15th 1720 —

I Humbly Certifie that in Obedience to the Commands of your Excellency
John Hart Esq. Governor of Maryland and the upper and Lower Houses
of Assembly now sitting I have Delivered Duplicates of what is Contained
in a paper giving notice to all papists to appear at a certain time in Said
Paper mentioned to make appear what right or Privileges of theirs (as they
have given out in Speech) are Infringed by the present Administration of
Government. To Henry Darnall William Digg John Digg Benjamin
Hale and Coment Hill of Prince Georges County Gentlemen and that I left
one other Copy of the same Paper for Mr Peter Atwood at the House of Mr
Benjamin Hale where the said Peter (as I have been told) was expected to
be in a day or two and I further Certifie that being Informed yesterday
that Mr Charles Digg was at Mr William Digg I sent one other Copy
of said Paper this Morning to the said William Digg in order to be
Delivered to the said Charles Digg to enquire Rich^d Keen Deputy Sheriff —

April the 16th 1720 —

His Excellency observes to this House that the Principall Papists had notice
given them as appears by the return of the Deputy Sheriff of Prince Georges County
by giving and leaving Copies of the resolve of this house for their appearance
here this Day therefore his Excellency proposes whether a List of those names
should not be Given the Door keeper to Inquire whether they are in town attend-
ing to be heard wth this house Conrads w^{ch} and it is ordered that a List of the names
of the said Persons be made and Delivered the Door keeper in order to Inquire whether
they are in town attending if List of the said Persons names are made & Delivered —
