May it please your Honor - We agree with your Honor that the Records ought to be secured from the weather and therefore have appointed Thomas Badley Esq^r of your house and Amos Grant Esq^r of our house (if they think fit) to undertake the same to inspect the Land and Secretaries Offices and to agree with workmen to make the necessary Repairs in Order to Secure the Records from any Damages they may sustain by means of the weather and so to make their Report thereon if the next Assembly -

As to the repairing the Records we desire the further Consideration of those who are to be appointed the next Session unless the Gentlemen appointed by the Law will proceed further therein according to the Directions of the Law signed by Order of the House No: 10: and sent to the Upper house by Coll: Wynson and Cap: Jones - who return and say they have delivered it -
