Thereupon Ordered that the Petitioner Give notice to the heirs of the said Deavour (if any there be) to appear next Sessions if they think fit and then make their objections against bringing in a bill on the behalf of the petitioner which was so Endorsed

On Reading the Petition of Tom Primor and the Provinciall Courts Representation thereon Resolved that any provinciall or County Justice take his own single recognizance in any reasonable time for his good behavior &c: and Discharge him from Prison thereon he paying fees

On reading yesterday Endorsement from the Upper house on the bill for Encouragement of Village &c: Resolved that the following message be prepared viz: By the Lower house of Assembly October the 18: 1722

May it please your Honours This house is willing to Decline any thing relating to the Manner of Tenders and the prices as proposed in the bill for Encouragement of Village &c: being willing that the prices remain as in the Act now in force But Desires your Hon: will (for the reasons by us before given by our Message by Col: Murchall and five others) Consent that Officers fees be paid by the severall Commodities in the said bill Specified as other Duties therein mentioned are to be paid — Signed of Order M: Jenifer for Lower House

which was sent with the bill aforesaid to the Upper house by M: Tyler and seven others they return and say they Delivered it — The Petition of the Inhabitants of Backmore County praying that a Town may be laid out where the County Court house no stands was read and Ordered that Col: James Maxwell have notice thereof that if he thinks fit he may appear next Sessions and make his objections if any there to

The petition of the Sherrife and Goalor of Ann Arundell County praying some Allowance for their fees due to them from the prisoners formerly Discharged by Act of Assembly as from those now to be Discharged was read and referred till the prisoners bill comes in — the petition of Eliz: and Thomas Gilbert was read again & rejected

The Petition of Tom Anglin of Ann Arundell County a poor prisoner was read & on hearing his Allegations as well of the petitioner as of Thomas Cokey Gent his Creditor the same is rejected — The Petition of Isaac Johns of Talbot County — and the petition of John Gresham of Ann Arundell County Gent

The petition of John Seager of St Marys County all complaining of sundry Hardships they have suffered by the Law were severally read and Ordered to be severally Endorsed viz: that it is the Opinion of this house that the petitioner has his remedy at Law if the facts alledged are true

Bill to Confirm Lands devised for the use of the Church was read the first time and Ordered to lye on the tables for further Consideration

The petition of James Loyd and John Bomberton Es: of Robert Grundy praying Leave to bring in a bill to Enable them to Convey severall tracts of Land sold by the (said)
