affairs was read the first and second times by Especiall Order past which was so
Endorsed and sent to the Upper house by M^r Blame and M^r Tyler - They return
and say they Delivered it - The Bill to Enable Hugh Mathews to sell Dennis
Sullivan's Land was read and ordered to be thus Endorsed ^{Bill} By the Upper
house of Assembly October the 23rd 1722 May it please your hon^s the opportunity
of Com^m w^t be Expences and their being but one hundred and fifty acres of land
to be sold the produce of which will not pay what the Testator's debts will exceed
his personal Estate so that there is a necessity of using all the good husbandry -
that can be to save charges. There fore it is proposed by this house that Hugh Mathews
the Ex: give now and good Security for the due Administ^r of the deceased Estate that that
