By the Upper house of Assembly October the 31st 1722 sent in Answer to your Message this day by Col^r Mackall and five others this house does appoint Col^r Waller & Chapman - Ward One of their Members / the house being then / to confer w^t the Committee appointed by your Province concerning the Matters therin proposed who is now ready to Enter thereon.

A Bill for the relief of such persons as have suffered by the Misconception of the Laws h^t to fore made to regulate the Making of Tobacco was read the first and second times by Especiall Order and part which was so endorset and sent to the Upper house by Mr. Cabb and Mr. Wallis - they return and say they delivered it - the following Message being prepared bz^t - By the Lower house of Assembly October the 31st 1722 -

May it please your Honours we are very sensible of the privileges of your House and the power invested in your H^rds in raising & applying the publick Money, and never had the least intention of invading or infringing either or to make any positive agreement with May^r Scowle or any other person on behalfe of the publick exclusive of your Hon^rs consent as the papers lay before our house we thought it would contribute to the Dispatch of Business to come to terms with May^r Scowle as soon as possible and to inform your hon^rs of our proceedings for your concurrence or alteration which we did with all the speed that could be and whilst May^r Scowle was in Town and as to the paym^t of 30000 l^ob^t for Indian rock it appeared to our house that May^r Scowle could have had the same price from other people were the Land clear of its Innumberances and conceived it inconsistent with the Rules of Justice to oblige a man to take less for Land than he takes from him for the publick good than he might set it for to his Abigilour therefore concurred if May^r Scowle have Right to the Land wh^t we think have been granted that he might have the same if he has no right his Right to have nothing - Signed by Col^r M. Jenifer to Lower house -

M^r plbury & Mr. Elliot - They return and say they delivered it - A Bill to prohibit the clandestine running of Tobacco into any of the Neighbouring Colonies was read the first and second times by Especiall Order and part which was so endorset and sent to the Upper house by Capt. Harrison and three more - They return and say they delivered it

A Bill Directing how fines shall be adjudged ag^t such as neglect to appear at Assizes was read the first and second times by Especiall Order and part which was so endorset and sent to the Upper house by Col^r Watts and Capt. Hudson - They return and say they delivered it

the following Message on Mr. Eggers Pet^t being prepared bz^t By the Lower house of Assembly October the 31st 1722 May it please your Hon^rs to have Considered Mr. Eggers petition and agree that the proposall will be of Service to the publick & therefore are willing to give him all reasonable Encouragement from time to time so far as will be Consistant with the Justice of this house and that he have the liberty of printing the acts of this province that shall be made for the future for the use of the publick &c &c
