Col. Holland from the Upper house Delivers Mr. Speaker the following Message viz
By the Upper house of assembly November the 8: 1722 Gent the Resolves of your house sent
by Col. Mackall & five others October the 31: being of the greatest consequence to the Lord
Proprietor and this Province and this Session of Assembly being near a conclusion we have not
time for so mature a consideration as the nature of them require & therefore have referred the
further Consideration of them till the next Session of Assembly viz: Nov: 3: 1722

An Engrost bill for the relief of Tom Griffin and Tom Jarvis languishing prisoners in
Calvert County and Robert Morris a languishing prisoner in Ann Arundell County was read
and reported to and being so Endorsed was sent to the Upper house by Mr. Dent & Mr. Hawkins
they return and say they delivered it - Ordered that Mr. Speaker do give his warrant to
the Secretary to make out an writ for Electing a Delegate to serve next Session for
Talbot County in the room of Col. Dr: Lloyd who this Session is made one of his Lordships
Honble Council - Ordered that Col. Mackall and Mr. Tyler go to the Upper house and acquaint
them that nothing of publick business remains before this house unfinished -

They return and say they delivered their Message - Col. Addison from the Upper
house acquaints Mr. Speaker that his hon: the Governor requires him and the whole
house to attend immediately in the Upper house and withdraw -

Thereupon Mr. Speaker with the whole house goe to the Upper house where his hon: the
Governour was pleased to Enact the severall Engrost bills following into Law by
sealing them with the Right Honble the Lord Proprietors great Seal of this Province and
severally thus Endorsing them viz: - On behalf of the Right Honble the Lord
Proprietor of this Province - I will this be a Law - Chas. Calvert -
