Ie. Be pleased to acquaint the House that I desire their attendance this afternoon at three of the Clock in order to see the Royall Assent given to the Bill of 3rd ph:

Pursuant to which Order the House adjourns to the Council Chamber to see his Excellency give the Agent on behalf of her Majestys an act for settling a Revenue on her Majestys Present Govr: which said Bill his Excellency the Governor was pleased to enact into a Law by sealing it with the Great Seal of this
