 Majestys Receivers to lay the whole accounts of the 3^d of Nov: + +
 appropriated for the purchase of Armes and Ammunition for
 the defence of that Province, before your house at the next
 Session

And further his Excellency and the Board do resolve and are
 inclinable some p^{te} of the aforesaid Revenue of 3^d of Nov: appropr^d
 as aforesaid may be applied towards the building publick
 Storehouses for preserving the publick Armes and Ammunition
 in the severall Countys where necessary

But as to the Storehouse agreed to be built in this City his
 Excellency desires it should not be further proceeded till the
 next Session of Assembly when some further proposals will
 be made relating thereto
