And further his Excell<sup>ty</sup> and the Board do resolve and are  
 inclinable some p<sup>ts</sup> of the aforesaid Revenue of 3<sup>o</sup> p<sup>ts</sup> approp<sup>ed</sup>  
 as aforesaid may be applied towards the building publick  
 Storehouses for preserving the publick Armes and Ammunition  
 in the severall Counties where necessary

But as to the Storehouse agreed to be built in this City his  
 Excell<sup>ty</sup> desires it should not be further proceeded till the  
 next Session of asembly when some further proposalls will  
 be made relating thereto
