

# Maryland

At an Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the twentieth day of April in the first year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of great Britain France and Ireland and the Dominions thereto belonging King Defender of the Faith & Prince of Denmark 1715 by virtue of his Majesty's writ of Election directed to the several and respective Sheriffs of the several Counties of this Province and to the Mayor Recorder and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, empowering the free holders of the several Counties to elect and chuse four Deputies or Delegates for each County, and the said Mayor Recorder and Aldermen to chuse two Citizens for the City aforesaid to serve as Representatives of the several Counties and City of Annapolis in this present General Assembly, which said writs bore date the seventeenth day of January 1714 returnable this 12<sup>th</sup> day of April 1715 aforesaid, at which time they assembled at the Stadthouse in the City of Annapolis aforesaid in the County of Ann Arundel the several Members following vizt.
