It is humbly offered to this Committee of Aggrievances that there is noe care taken to appoint some Carefull Men in every County to heare & determine all manner of differences and disputes that shall arise between the English and the Indians.

It is further humbly offered to this Committee that it is an Aggrievance that severall Sheriffs within this Province makes an advantage of that Law, that says they shall be obliged to receive Money at 1st for Tobacco due in the Publig by the twenty fifth day of December, noe time being ascertained in the Law when to pay it away when Tobacco is a Comoditie will neither pay nor discount with those that has Claims on them without they have some reward for soe doing.
