appeared before the barr of this House and being demanded by Mr. Goring
what account they could give of the Magazine and armes delivered to
Col^d Cortes in his life time out of the Publick Store in Annapolis as
appeared by a copy of his Receipt Read to them by Mr. Speaker, time is
given them to produce their accounts till the afternoon at which
time they are ordered to attend.

The House adjourns till one a clock in the afternoon.

our house of Assembly in Mansfield at the City of Annapolis to
be held the 4th day of June next there to give your Reasons if any there
be why an act may not pass for Confirmation of a Will of Mr.
Parimore late of Somerset County in favour of the three Cohens of
Arnold Parimore concerning a tract of Land Myluxion lying in
Somerset County which is the desire in behalfe of the Heires of Mr.
Cadwell Jun^r - April the 2^d 1715. then came John Davis
