It is further humbly offered to this Committee as an grievance that any Court of Records within this Province should be admitted to suffer any fine or recovery to be made to Cutt of any Intails of Lands it being lately understood to be obtained in the Prov. Courts.

All which foregoing grievances are humbly offered by this Committee to this house for their consideration thereof.
